On the basis of its membership with The Royal Aal al-Bayt Institute for Islamic Thought, The Supreme Council of Islamic Affairs in the Republic of Chad promoted the World Interfaith Harmony Week amongst nearing Islamic countries and urged them to carry out relevant events during that same week. This has been clarified in the letter sent by the Cultural and Social Development Charity Association in the Cameroon.
