

## PEACE REVIVAL AND RECONCILIATION FOUNDATION OF NIGERIA:

Started celebrating "World Interfaith Harmony Week" in Kaduna State of Nigeria, West Africa from the last week of January to the 8th week of March 2018. The foundation took its campaign to the following places:-

1. In the last week of January, we visited worship places i.e Churches and mosques wherein we distributed praying mats and kettles to places visited.
2. From the 1st-7th of February, we visited a drug rehabilitation centre(Niggas Rehabilitation Center) where we conducted seminar on the deradicalization of drug addition and religious extremism and fundamentality. Visited the physically challenged people and orphanage home.
3. Visited Hausa traditional barbers and Religious Scholars (both Islamic and Christian).
4. Visited youths groups, held talks on religious tolerance and mutual understanding. A peace and Harmony football match was then organized for both Muslim and Christian youth within Kaduna metropolis which ended peacefully.
5. Visited Communities for enlightenment on religious tolerance and Harmony including foreign nationals such as Nigeria Turkish International College.
6. In the 3rd week of February, we visited both muslim and Christian ethnic groups and family meetings to encourage them on living in Harmony.
7. Visited the headquarters of National Union of Journalists as well as media organizations where we canvassed for collaboration in the area of enlightenment on religious tolerance and Harmony.
8. Between the last week of February and the 1st week of March, there was a religious conflict on intermarriage between Christians and Muslims at Kasuwan Magani, Kajuru local government area and another one at Mararaban Rido, chikun local government area where a mosque was burnt in the process. Peace Revival took advantage of the situation to take the campaign of religious tolerance and Harmony to both areas and the result was fruitful. The people welcomed the idea in which they interacted amongst themselves under the Supervision of the President, peace Revival and reconciliation foundation of Nigeria, Pastor YOHANNA Y.D BURU. At the end of both meetings, issues were resolved amicably and the people were appreciative.
