



PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS the World Interfaith Harmony Week was first proposed at the UN General Assembly on September 23, 2010 by H.M. King Abdullah II of Jordan;

AND WHEREAS the 2010 UN General Assembly approved unanimously the first week of February as the UN World Interfaith Harmony Week, according to the proposal

And WHEREAS the UN World Interfaith Harmony is officially placed under the patronage of H.M. King Abdullah of Jordan;

WHEREAS The Constitution provides for the freedom to practice the rights of one's religion and faith in accordance with the customs that are observed in the Kingdom, unless they violate public order or morality.;

And NOTING that The City of Amman is proud to be known for upholding and fostering interfaith harmony, and for hosting the annual awards ceremony of the World Interfaith Harmony Week;

THEREFORE, I, Mayor of Amman do hereby proclaim February 1-7, beginning in 2017 as the annual UN World Interfaith Harmony Week in Banjul, and Amman's participation in "Mayors and Cities for Interfaith Harmony" (interfaith.org) as a Founding Participating City;
