### **January 20 at 12:15- 15:30: Brunch Fellowship**

*Venue: Simon Peters House, Islandsvej 4 at 4-6 pm.*

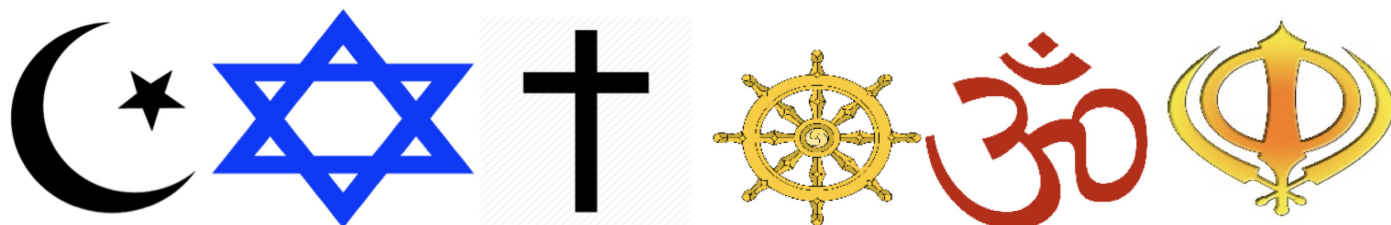
### **February 23: Painting Workshop on Symbols in Religions.**
