Back Ground:

Dr.W.A.Deshapriya S. Wijetunge is a social leader in Sri Lanka. He has been involved in Peace Initiatives, Peace Missions and Social services for more than 20 years. He is a Founder Member of SUNFO which was inaugurated on 22 May 1999 under the patronage of Hon. Speaker of the Parliament of Sri Lanka & blessings of United Nations Resident Coordinator. He serves as Director General of SUNFO.

In year 2000 at the convocation of World Leaders held at the United Nations ,NewYork . Dr.Wijetunge was appointed as an Ambassador of Peace by IIFWP. He was a member of the delegation of Building an Eastern Alliance for World Peace in 2000 travelled in many Asian nations .Dr.Wijetunge was involved in addressing peace conferences across Sri Lanka and the world for the “UN Decade of Building a Culture of Peace & Non-Violence for the Children of the World”.(2001-2010).In year 2002 he organized a thousand member delegation of Children and society leaders to go from South to war effected North in Sri Lanka a special mission named as “Journey of Friendship from South to North”. He has involved in Millennium Development Goals (MDG) and Sustainable Development Goals (SDG) campaigns , mobilizations and advocacy. He has trained thousands of Peace Leaders .He has travelled more than 50 countries and addressed many peace conferences, summits and gatherings. He has won many awards, honorary titles. He has mobilized over one million people in MDG-SDG campaigns. He pioneered to build “Peace Dagaba”(Anguruwathota), “Symbol of Peace”(Sri jayawardenapura) Sri Lanka’s one and only Inter-religious Peace & Harmony Monument with Mahatma Gandhi Non-Violence Statue symbolizing 11 World Major Religions.(Lunawa)

29. National Inter-religious Symposium



This was held at Kadiragarmar Institute Auditorium, Colombo 7 on 8 Feb 2019 with over 250 delegates coordinated by Mr.Saman of National peace Council of Sri Lanka.

report of National Inter Religious Symposium held at Laxman Kadhirgamar institute of International Studies on 8 February 2019.

Dr. Jayampathi Wickramaratne (MP) well explained about the report published by the steering committee to the experts committee to make proposals to the new constitution. He said that document is not a draft for the new constitution and it is only a report and it carried a set of proposals under the different components to include in the constitution. Political parties and academic people also are expressing their point of views on the report of steering committee of parliament constitutional committee. A report prepared by the panel of experts for the steering committee based on the Interim report, six subcommittee reports, the report of the ad hoc subcommittee set up by the steering committee to look into the relationship between the parliament and the provincial councils. The chapters on fundamental rights and freedom, language rights and directive principles of state policy contained in the report are those proposed by the subcommittee on fundamental rights.

He pointed out that some people try to raise their concerns only focusing on certain words without looking at the content of the report and the report clearly explained that it proposed only for Sri Lanka to be a Unitary Country but not for a federal state.

National Peace Council of Sri Lanka, in collaboration with **Civil Society and Trade Union's Collective** organized this National Symposium to discuss on current political situation in the country especially on proposed new constitution. It was held on 8 February 2019 at Laxman Kadhirgamar institute of International Studies from 2.00 pm to 7.00 pm.

Over 250 people representing civil society and trade unions attended the symposium. Forty eight (48) inter religious leaders including 23 Buddhist monks, 9 Maulavies, 8 Kurukkals and 8 Christian clergy were among the participants. Altogether 92 representatives came from District Inter Religious Committees established by NPC. Other participants represented different sectors such as trade unions and civil society organizations that not working with NPC. We arranged transport facility only for our DIRC member and other participants came on their own expenses.

We expected only 130 participants for this event as seating facility at the hall is only available for 130 people and so that arranged quite a number of extra plastic chairs and other participants more than 50 remained standing until the end of the event because of their interest on the topic discussed.
