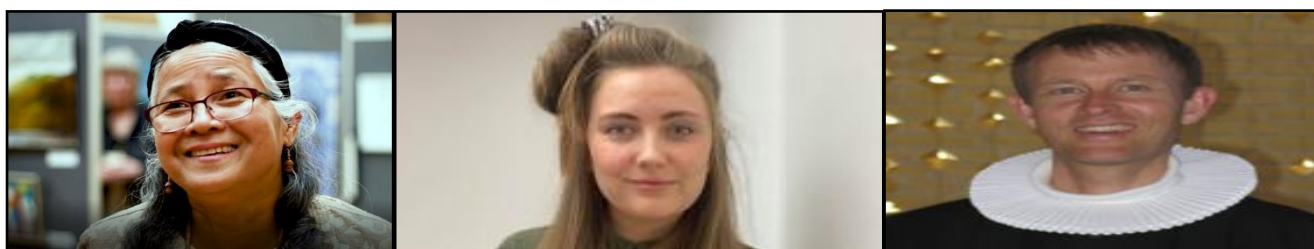
### The Cross-cultural Ministry of Kolding Deanery
