

REPORT: WORLD INTERFAITH HARMONY WEEK 2023

Interfaith breakfast about Fraternity

February 3, 2023 – 10:00am – 13:00 Buenos Aires, Argentina



The Alba Intercultural Dialogue Center in Buenos Aires, Argentina organized an interfaith breakfast as part of the initiative of The NYC Journalists and Writers Foundation and its Global Interfaith Partners who promoted a series of events during World Interfaith Harmony Week, an annual event held during the first week of February each year (February 1-7), following the designation by the United Nations General Assembly in 2010. Recognizing the imperative need for dialogue between different faiths and religions to enhance mutual understanding, harmony and cooperation among people, this initiative involves the celebration of interfaith harmony events for 7 days. The main objective is to build bridges around the world and spread the message of interfaith harmony and goodwill among the different religions of the world.

The Alba Intercultural Dialogue Center organized an interfaith breakfast to create a space for dialogue and fraternal coexistence between faiths that coexist in harmony in Argentina. The breakfast took place at the Center's headquarters on February 3, 2023, at 10:00 am.

Resume of the event: In this interfaith breakfast of fraternity, we met with different representatives of the interfaith area to celebrate the International Day of Fraternity and we shared fraternity experiences that allowed us to get to know each other better and build new bonds of friendship. After breakfast, we drew lots to make pairs of "hayirhah", which means friendship, that will allow us to take this experience to the daily life of each one of us. Finally, we watched a short video clip called "Hola Hermano" (Hello Brother) to remind us that it is possible to build a peaceful world and to avoid conflicts through fraternity.
