

Interfaith Scotland World Interfaith Harmony Week Report 2024 **Faces of Faith Exhibition**



Students and faculty members at Napier University in Edinburgh celebrated the installation of Interfaith Scotland's Faces of Faith exhibition on Thursday 1st February, 2024.

The storytelling and photography exhibition was hosted in the university's Merchiston Campus foyer from January 26th to February 7th as part of World Interfaith Harmony Week.

The exhibition is a showcase of Scotland's diverse religious and cultural communities. The stories of sixteen people explore the joys, challenges, and complexities of living as a person of faith in Scotland, and the impact these communities have on a local, national, and international level.

One of the people featured in the exhibition, Anish Subramaniam, spoke at the university event about his personal faith journey and experiences with interfaith dialogue. Anish is a member of Interfaith Scotland's National Interfaith Youth Advisory Board and talked about the opportunities young people have to engage in interfaith work.

Attendees at the event also heard from the author of the exhibition's stories, and Interfaith Scotland staff member, Jill Stevens. She spoke about her experience of interviewing those featured in the

exhibition and answered questions about the story writing process and the creation of the exhibition.

Dozens of students attended the event alongside Napier University's new staff Interfaith Network. It was a great opportunity for people to chat, share their experiences and meet people who are similarly passionate about celebrating diversity and inclusivity.
