

Scouts in Action – Building Bridges through Interfaith Dialogue

Episode 1 of International Dialogue Centre KAICIID's Youth Webinar Series "NextGen TALKS" Faith in Action: Youth-led Projects Making a Difference



The first session of the **NextGen TALKS** webinar series, titled "**Scouts in Action – Building Bridges through Interfaith Dialogue,"** launched the International Dialogue Centre - KAICIID's new **Youth Series** in collaboration with its **E-Learning Unit, Arab Region Programme, and Capacity Building Hub**. This 30-minute session featured **Amana El Zoobi**, a 21-year-old Lebanese scout, who shared her experiences in **youth leadership and interfaith engagement** within scouting.



The discussion highlighted two key initiatives:

- With Faith, We Are Stronger (2020): A summer camp fostering interfaith dialogue among scouts.
- Arab Youth Scout Forum (2023): A programme promoting inclusivity and diversity within scouting.

These initiatives incorporated interfaith prayer events, food aid programmes, COVID-19 awareness, and sustainability efforts, supported by KAICIID's Dialogue 360 project under its Arab Region Programme. The session emphasized the role of scouting as a model for grassroots interfaith collaboration, strengthening community ties and intercultural understanding.

The discussion also explored youth-led strategies for fostering mutual respect, breaking barriers, and promoting social cohesion. Amana highlighted how scouting provides a supportive space for youth to gain confidence, develop leadership skills, and engage in meaningful dialogue with people from different faith traditions.

Through an interactive Q&A session, participants addressed practical approaches to interfaith dialogue, overcoming barriers to participation, and expanding international youth exchanges. The session reinforced the importance of scouting as a tool for social change, preparing young people to become active peacebuilders and cultural ambassadors.

Impact Assessment

This event significantly contributed to the mission of World Interfaith Harmony Week, demonstrating how youth-led initiatives in scouting promote interfaith understanding and community cohesion. Key impacts included:

- **Empowering Youth for Leadership in Interfaith Dialogue** By showcasing **youth-driven** initiatives, the event highlighted how scouting fosters leadership, responsibility, and social engagement in interfaith settings.
- Creating Inclusive Spaces for Dialogue The event emphasized the importance of structured interfaith and intercultural activities, such as summer camps and forums, in providing safe spaces for meaningful exchange.



- Strengthening Youth Participation in Peacebuilding The discussion addressed barriers preventing young people from engaging in interfaith work, proposing mentorship, training, and small-scale community actions as solutions.
- Encouraging Cross-Cultural and International Exchange The Arab Youth Scout Forum was presented as a successful model for cross-cultural learning and collaboration, with potential for replication across other regions.
- Fostering New Networks and Partnerships The webinar facilitated peer learning and engagement between young peacebuilders, scouting networks, and interfaith organizations, setting the stage for future cooperation.

By elevating youth voices, encouraging practical actions, and reinforcing the role of scouting in interfaith dialogue, this event aligned with World Interfaith Harmony Week's mission, promoting peace and understanding across diverse communities.
