## Sustaining the Culture of Peace: Reflections on the Town Hall for Peace in Holeta

On February 28, 2025, Holeta hosted a pivotal gathering during the #WIHW2025 celebrations, where EIFDDA's Town Hall for Peace brought together over 40 diverse faith leaders, community members, and peace advocates. Throughout the day, participants engaged in in-depth discussions and workshops on
